

Itinerary 20 Day Tour 3 Countries: Namibia Botswana Zimbabwe

Day 1:

Arrival at Hosea Kutako (Windhoek International) Airport, where you are met by your guide. Transfer to the capital of Namibia for check-in at apartments in the city.

Windhoek is a city of many contrasts. Modern skyscrapers blend with historic buildings dating from the turn of the century. Several buildings from the German colonial era have been preserved and restored to fulfill useful functions in the community today.



Day 2:

We depart to Luderitz

It is a harbour town in the Karas region of southern Namibia, lying on one of the least hospitable coasts in Africa. On the way we might be lucky and see some of the desert wild horses.

Luderitz is a port developed around Robert Harbour and Shark Island.




Day 3:

We visit the Ghost town Kolmanskop. It is a ghost town in the Namib desert 10 kilometres inland from the port town of Lüderitz. It was named after a transport driver Johnny Coleman who, during a sand storm, abandoned his ox wagon on a small incline opposite the settlement. Once a small but very rich mining village, it is now a tourist destination.

We also visit the Diaz point

The bay on which Lüderitz is situated was first known to Europeans when Bartolomeu Dias encountered it in 1487. He named the bay Angra Pequena (Portuguese: Small Bay) and erected a padrão (stone cross) on the southern peninsula. ... Lüderitz thus began its life as a trading post.



Day 4:

We travel from Luderitz to the Sesriem area where we will sleep 2 nights.



Day 5:

We head out early in the morning (05:00) to visit Sossusvlei, a clay pan surrounded by some of the highest sand dunes in the world, which is filled only with water in years when exceptionally good rainfall is received and also Deadvlei where you can climb the famous Big Daddy dune.

We enjoy a picnic in the dunes, whereafter we visit the Sesriem Canyon.



Day 6:

We drive to Swakopmund. It is a quaint desert town with its old-world charm and relaxed atmosphere hedged by desert and sea, is enhanced by lush green lawns and palm trees. The route takes you through the scenic low plains of the Namib Desert via the fascinating geological rock formations of the Kuiseb Canyon



Day 7:
In the morning we visit the marine aquarium in Swakopmund before we travel to the moon land scape and we visit Walvis Bay



Day 8:

We travel north along the skeleton coast to Cape Cross.

The best-known breeding colony of Cape fur seals along the Namib coast is at this reserve, where the population has grown large and fat by taking advantage of the rich concentrations of fish in the cold Benguela Current. The sight of more than 100,000 seals basking on the beach and frolicking in the surf is impressive to behold, though you're going to have to contend with the overwhelming odoriferousness of piles and piles of stinky seal poo.



From Cape Cross we travel to the old mining town in Damaraland Uis where we sleep over.

Day 9:

We travel to a Twyfelfontein where we visit the petrified forrest and we visit ancient bushmen engravings.

We sleep close to Khorixas.

Day 10:



We travel to the Etosha National Park.

At the heart of this National Park is the Etosha Pan, a vast dry shallow depression. Perennial springs feed the waterholes along the southern verge, which attract a myriad of animal species.

Day 11:

Discover the mysteries of the African bush in Etosha National Park. We spend the day doing game drives in the park and visit the numerous waterholes that attract a large diversity of animal and bird species, many of these being endemic to the country.

Day 12:

We travel to the eastern part of the park and exit the park to sleep over in Tsumeb.

Day 13:

We travel to the Okavango region sleeping over at a lodge close to Divundu.

Day 14:

We do a game drive in the Mahango reserve and we visit the Poppa Falls.



Day 15:

We travel to Katima Mulilo to Impalila Island where we stay for 3 nights

Day 16:

We do game viewing from a boat on the Chobe river and game drive in the Chobe National Park

Day 17:



We go on a day excursion to Victoria Falls - Zimbabwe

Day 18:We travel to Maun in Botswana where you can enjoy game drives and evening Mukoro rides



Day 19:

We travel to Windhoek.
