

## **Namibia 5 Day Lodging Tour**

### What is included:

- 1) Guide & 4x4 vehicle
- 2) Accommodation
- 3) Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

### <u>Itinerary:</u>

### Day 1 (Windhoek-Namib Naukluft Park )

We will pick you up from your hotel or guest house at 7:30 am and depart straight on the way south to world-famous world heritage site Sossusvlei via the picturesque Spreetshoogte Pass. We will then have a Stop-over at the viewpoint to appreciate the endless view of the Namib. Our lunch will be at the Solitaire oasis for your own cost. We will arrive at a Desert Lodge at around 3-4 pm. This time is extremely hot, we recommend that you spend the day cooling off by the pool. Dinner at the lodge is included. Rest is required as tomorrow you are expected to wake early in the morning.



### Day 2 Dune 45, Sossusvlei - Desert Experience

Early in the morning, after breakfast that is included, we will travel to the Sesriem Gate to the remarkable Sossusvlei. We start off with climbing the picturesque Dune 45, experiencing beauty and vastness of the Orange-colored landscape. Then it is an Off-road drive to the Dead Vlei, a place of Vast desert pan where dried-up, ancient acacia trees stand silent in an impressive, open-air gallery. If you have enough energy, you can climb one of the highest dunes on Earth, the ,Big Daddy 'or ,Big Mama. After the morning excursion, we will return back to Sesriem for lunch. We will take a break for 1-2 hours. Once the heat subsides, we will take a short excursion to Sesriem Canyon. This will be our last activity for the day. Overnight at a Desert Lodge with Dinner included.

Optional: Hot Air Baloon flight +- N\$ 5000



#### Day 3 Sossusvlei to Swakopmund

Today after breakfast we will move from desert to sea. On our way we will cross the Tropic of Capricorn and traverse the Gaub and the Kuiseb passes, driving down to the dry river bed at the bottom of the Kuiseb Canyon before climbing up the other side and watching the spectacular desert landscape unfold before us. Having arrived at the coast, we will make a stop in Walvis Bay to enjoy the view of flamingos and other birds in the lagoon. We will take a short break for lunch. We overnight in Swakopmund at a hotel. Dinner tonight is at the client's own expense in a local restaurant of your choice. The hotel is in the city centre walking distance from all the major attractions and restaurants.



### Day 4 Swakopmund- Etosha National Park

We depart at 08:00 as we have a long drive today. On our way we will stop in Usakos to fill up with fuel and provisions. We will have lunch in Outjo. We are expected to arrive at Okaukuejo in the Etosha National Park in the afternoon. We will drive through some parts of the National park in search of various animals. We will be at our lodge at Okaukuejo inside the Etosha National Park or similar just before sunset. Dinner that is included will sum-up the adventure and rest will be required so that we can be able to wake up early and fresh for the full day driving through Etosha National Park. And back to Windhoek.



#### Day 5 Etosha to Windhoek

Be prepared for the long, scenic transit back to Windhoek. We pass through Etosha while visiting various waterholes in search of animals to Namutoni where we can do a quick stop for lunch. We will travel through towns and rural areas, stopping in the small town of Okahandja, the home of Namibia's largest wood carving market. The stalls operate on a local co-operative basis and offer a vast array of truly Namibian souvenirs.

We are due back in Windhoek early evening where you will be dropped off at your hotel or guest house.
